PERMANENT LABOR CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

EMPLOYER: Washington University in St. Louis

POSITION: Senior Lecturer

DUTIES: The position will serve in the Department of Physics at Washington University's School of Arts and Sciences, primarily teaching Introductory Physics to undergraduate students. The position will also be responsible for the following: prepare and deliver lectures, lead a variety of in-class activities, such as solving example problems, facilitating conceptual discussions, and conducting demonstrations to illustrate core concepts; hold regular office hours, mentor the online discussion board, and meet with students who need additional support; oversee and develop content for a peer mentor program that supports students in building their problem-solving skills through group work; assign final grades; and supervise graduate and undergraduate teaching assistants who assist with grading homework and exams. In addition, the position will contribute to the design of the course structure, syllabus, assignments, exams and other instructional materials based on current evidence-based pedagogical principles, as well as work on innovative pedagogically motivated updates to the course. The position will also teach a weekly 50-minute recitation section designed for prospective physics majors, focusing on strengthening their problem-solving abilities, and may also be required to teach upper-level undergraduate physics courses.

REQUIREMENTS: The position is located in St. Louis, Missouri. Requires a Ph.D. in Physics or closely related field (or foreign equivalent).
